

Wauwatosa to launch weekly farmers market

Starting June 5, 2010, Wauwatosa will have its own farmers market. "Tosa Farmers Market," a project of the Fire Fly Foundation, Ltd., is a volunteer-run open air market that brings locally-grown fruits and vegetables and foods crafted by Wisconsin artisans directly to the people of Wauwatosa and surrounding communities. The market is located on the municipal parking lot underneath the Underwood Bridge between Hoyt and Hart parks along the Menomonee River, next to the historic "The Little Red Store" (7720 Harwood Avenue).

Tosa Farmers Market is more than just a place to buy fresh fruits and veggies -- it's a community gathering spot that will feature hot food and coffee, live music, and cooking demonstrations every week, along with monthly visits from the storytellers of Tuesdays at Ten. Enjoy the market and then stroll through the charming Village of Wauwatosa afterward. Then make a visit to the shops and restaurants of North Avenue on Tosa's East Side, or take a ride on the Oak Leaf bike trail along the Menomonee River using a rental bike from the Little Red Store.

Stop by between the hours of **8 a.m. and Noon** every **Saturday*** from **June through October** to experience this dynamic market.
